



Update for SA Harness Racing participants – 7th July 2020

Now that we in SA are progressing to the other side of COVID-19 it is appropriate that we look toward easing some of the restrictions with respect to participant requirements on race days.

From this Saturday (11th July) forward, we will no longer be conducting temperature testing upon arrival at the track.

However, the requirement of having to notify who will be in attendance (stable hands) remains the same. This being that only those nominated as stable hands will be permitted entry to the stables area.

HRSA request that you always practice social distancing and social density and observe instructions from Stewards and Officials at all times.

One further relaxation is that, also from this coming Saturday onward, the driver's colours requirement has been removed - in consequence drivers will now wear those colours designated to the horse's respective trainer.

Finally, the road to where we now find ourselves has been a hard, yet rewarding one. The continuity of racing being first and foremost in all decision making processes. HRSA would like to thank everyone for their indulgence and co-operation in assisting to achieve this outcome and we wish you well in your upcoming engagements.
