



NOTICE TO ALL SA HARNESS RACING PARTICIPANTS

Access To Race Meetings

As previously advised, until further notice, attendance at all South Australian harness racing meetings will be restricted to only those persons involved with the facilitation of the meeting. This being trainers, drivers, stablehands, officials and other duly authorised persons. With particular regard to licensed persons, only those with horses engaged will be allowed entry.

Furthermore, the numbers of licensed persons associated with each stable must be proportionate to the number of horses engaged.

No unlicensed person will be permitted entry in connection with any horse.

All licensed and authorised participants must enter each relevant venue through the float park.

UPON ARRIVAL AT THE CHECKING AREA YOU MUST PRODUCE YOUR APPROPRIATE HARNESS RACING LICENCE OR YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ENTRY. Please note that a security officer (s) will be on duty at this checking point.

The measures announced have been taken to best position harness racing for the obvious challenges to be faced moving forward, and to protect the health and well-being of all those involved in our industry. We therefore ask that you respect the measures taken and comply with the directives issued.

Finally, if you are concerned that you may have been exposed to, or are experiencing symptoms of COVID19, please contact your health provider or a medical professional immediately. Please also inform the Chairman of Stewards should either you suspect you may be infected with or you have undergone a test for the virus but are awaiting the results.
